

# Arpeggio Fingerings

## Major Arpeggios

Note: These fingerings aren't as hard and fast as scale fingerings. Try these out first but feel free to change them if they don't fit your hands well

Note: These are the fingerings for 2 octaves. For 4 octaves just repeat the pattern

### C Major
